THEEXPLORER'S ROUTE

Day O

5th May | Reach Siliguri | 0-KM

Arrive in Siliguri - the gateway to North-East India and get ready to embark on an unforgettable journey. Before the journey begins, the Dominars will undergo a thorough check by our experts on board, and the riders will undergo a detailed debriefing session with the ride coordinator Sarath Shenoy

Day 1 6th May | Siliguri to Pelling via Darjeeling | 142-KM

After the debriefing session, kick-start your adventure with a scenic ride

from Siliguri to Pelling via Darjeeling. Explore the beautiful tea gardens and colonial architecture of Darjeeling before riding through winding mountain roads around the cosy town of Pelling.

7th May | Pelling to Mangan via Kanchenjunga falls -

Ravangla - Mangan | 170-KM The second day will be all about the unmatched scenic views of the

Greater Himalayan range and Mt. Kanchenjunga enoute the biggest waterfall in Sikkim, i.e. Kanchenjunga waterfall, and Bon Monastery, one of only two of its kind in India. Take in the breathtaking views and stop for a cup of tea at a local tea stall. The 170-Kilometre circuit will end at the welcoming town of Mangan.

Day 3 8th May | Mangan to Lachen via Naga Falls | 80-KM

The third day will be about the curious explorer in us, with a circuit of 80 kilometres beginning at Mangar to reach Lachen via the Naga falls.

Being the base to the most incredible treks in Sikkim, Lachen is lined with beautiful wooden houses that offer a cosy stay.

9th May | Lachen to Lachung via Gurudongmar | 180-KM

180-Kilometre circuit starting at Lachen to explore the Gurudongmar lake, one of the highest lakes in the world with an altitude of 17,800 ft. A magical fact about this lake is that even at 17,800 ft., it never freezes. Also, do not

On the sixth day, we will resume our journey from Katao to reach the heart of Sikkim, i.e. Gangtok. With its historical significance and the surrounding aura of Buddhism that dates back to the 1840s, our 118-kilometre circuit will be all about uncovering the hidden secrets of Sikkim.
