Dominar Riders from Mumbai assemble at the M2M ferry (Princess Dock, Mazgaon). Riders from Pune either join the Mumbaikars at the M2M ferry or start with the second batch that flags off from their city.

Before the journey begins, all the bikes will undergo a thorough inspection and the riders will undergo a detailed debriefing session. Both groups then meet up at a pre-decided lunch spot and ride together to the destination.

BEGINNING THE VOYAGE FROM MUMBAI/PUNE TO DIVEAGAR

Fort, ferry rides, with a dash of waterfalls and lighthouses - that's all part of the many historic discoveries you will be making on the first day. Korlai Fort, for example, was built in 1521 and was once used to house 7,000 horses and an equal number of men. And you thought Konkan was just about the beaches!





DIVING INTO THE DEPTHS FROM DIVEAGAR TO DAPOLI

The ride to Dapoli will see you riding through scenic beaches at Aravi, Srivardhan, and Anjarle.
The high point? Witnessing life find a way at the Velas Turtle Festival where newborn Olive Ridley Turtles are released into the Arabian Sea.



COASTAL REVELATIONS FROM DAPOLI TO RATNAGIRI

A pure coastal ride, Day 3 will see you warm up for the roads of Ratnagiri. The high of revving through the straight roads adjacent to Guhagar beach will be matched only by the excitement of careening around the hairpins leading to Jaigad Fort. Fun fact - the fort is one of the few of its kind in India that's located at the meeting point of a hill,

`a river, and the sea.
